



Corporate Membership Agreement

_____ (Name of Company, hereinafter called the "Corporation") wishes to establish a Corporate Membership with the Good Shepherd Institute for Healthy Living. Said Corporation recognizes the use of its company title and agrees to maintain the three (3) adult minimum for the corporate discount on membership.

Corporate rates will vary depending on employee population. Memberships of individual employees is contingent on the employee signing all applicable membership agreements and releases and adhering to the policies of the Institute. Three active employees are required for a company to qualify for corporate memberships starting at 20 percent off. Payments will be made by one of the methods below:

OPTION 1

- Split Billing** - The company will receive an invoice each month for the agreed percentage that it will be contributing toward the employee memberships, and the remainder of the membership, less Good Shepherd Institute for Healthy Living discount, will be set up to automatically draft from the employee's checking account or credit card account. The Corporation understands that at least 10 percent of the monthly membership dues for an individual will be covered by the corporation. The Corporation may contribute as much as it wishes beyond 10 percent payment for memberships under this method.

OPTION 2

- Employee Draft** - The Good Shepherd Institute for Healthy Living will draft on the 3rd of every month the membership dues out of the employee's individual checking, savings or credit card. The corporate representative will be responsible for submitting a termed employee list every 90 days to the Good Shepherd Institute for Healthy Living.

OPTION 3

- Payment in Full** - The Good Shepherd Institute for Healthy Living will send an invoice for the total of all employee memberships and the company will pre-pay or pay in full for all employee memberships. This method will qualify for an additional 10 percent off.

The designated Corporate Representative is responsible for adhering to the Good Shepherd Institute for Healthy Living cancellation policy by providing thirty (30) day written notice to the Business Office for any cancellation of a Corporate member. Any amounts that have already been billed to the company for an employee membership will not be refunded except for extenuating circumstances, as determined by the Good Shepherd Institute for Healthy Living. Prorated amounts for the 30 days notice will be sent to the company, or drafted from the employee's personal account as a final bill.

The Corporation agrees to provide the Good Shepherd Institute for Healthy Living Corporate Membership to its employees under all agreements above. This agreement may be terminated after the initial twelve (12) months by giving a thirty (30) day written notice to the Good Shepherd Institute for Healthy Living Business Office. If written notice is not received, the Corporate Membership will automatically renew on a month-to-month basis _____ (initials). If the company cancels its Corporate membership agreement, each member on the Corporate Membership will lose their corporate rate at the end of their contract. Rates for members on the Corporate Membership are subject to change depending on the matching discount efforts of the Corporation.
